

ANNUAL REPORT

Preamble:

The South Central Railway State Bharat Scouts and Guides has the largest strength of Scouts and Guides amongst the Indian Railways with a strong force of 3,500 Scouts, Guides, Rovers, Rangers and Adult Leaders. Under the dynamic leadership of our Patron Sri Gajanan Mallya, General Manager, due to the pandemic since April 2020 very few of activities were undertaken during the year 2020-21. It was the constant guidance of Sri. Vikram Gupta, State Commissioner (Scouts) & CE/C-VI/HQ, Smt K.Padmaja, State Commissioner (Guides) and Sri A.K.Rawat, State Secretary & Secy/PG/SCR.

National/State events:

- ➤ Rovers of BZA District conducted awareness campaign to the migrant laborers on importance of Hand Wash, Social Distance and wearing of face mask in connection with COVID-19.
- > They also distributed raw materials like Rice, Toor daal, Oil etc.
- ➤ Around 55 Rover/Rangers along with Scout Appointee/Employees rendered valuable service in door to door distribution of medicine to the pensioners/employees during the Lockdown period. The program was successfully organized for a period of 60 days which was appreciated by one and all.
