Sub : System improvement to reduce unauthorised vending.

During the meeting held in SDGM's chamber with Public Prosecutors, the problem of unauthorized vending has come for discussion. It was felt in the meeting that one of the main problems faced while dealing the above cases is imposition of small amount of penalty on the offenders. The Public Prosecutors informed that Railways are not able to present these cases by providing past history of the offences like repeatedly doing unauthorized vending, previous penalty imposed on them etc.

In this regard, it is suggested that a data base of offenders caught doing unauthorized vending should be maintained along-with that photograph/s by concerned supervisors and while producing them in the hon'ble Courts, this data can be utilized by mentioning the number of incidents they were caught previously for the same offence along with previous convictions also to enable the hon'ble Court to impose higher fines on them.

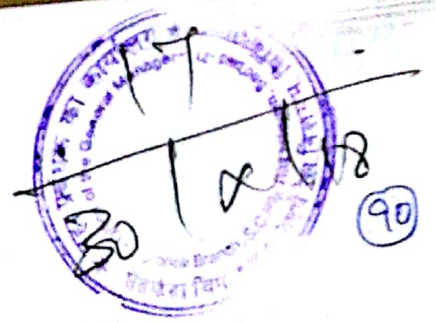

8-10-18 from Dy. Chief Vigilance Officer/Traffic/SC.

Dy. Chief Vigilance Officer/Traffic/SC, vide letter cited above advised that during the meeting held by Sd. GM with Public Prosecutor it has come to light that Railways are not presenting the cases of unauthorised vending properly in the Railway Courts leading to imposition of small amount of penalty on the offenders by the Hon'ble Courts.

In view of this it is advised to instruct all the Magistrate batch In-charges to maintain a data base of offenders with photos and present the past history of the offenders, such as the number of times prosecuted earlier for the same offence at the time of filing charge sheet so that, Hon'ble Courts will be able to impose heavy fine/imprisonment which will act as deterrent on these offenders, by which in the long run, the menace of unauthorised vending can be eliminated.

All the Magistrate Squads may please suitably instructed accordingly.
