Reference to the note cited above, it is advised that, PFA, Sr.DPOs/Sr.DFM of all divisions, WPOs/WAOs of all workshops have been instructed to adhere to the following procedure while dealing with the cases of wards of railway employees in receipt of family pension considered for appointment on compassionate grounds (CG) vide this office letter of even No. dated 29.10.2019:

(i) A declaration should invariably be obtained from the ward of the ex. employee whether he is drawing family pension or otherwise at the time of considering appointment under compassionate grounds.

(ii) Whenever the ward of the ex. railway employee who is in receipt of family pension is considered for appointment on compassionate grounds, the fact that such ward of the ex. employee has joined the railways on CG should be intimated without fail to Associate Accounts Officer who will take necessary action for stopping the family pension and authorising family pension to other eligible family member, if any, indicated in the PPO.

(iii) The Accounts officer should immediately send an advice to the respective Bank to stop payment of family pension to the ward appointed on CG, duly endorsing a copy to the Personnel department of the Division/Unit/Hqrs. for information and record.
