**Sub:** To get the opinion of Law Officer-Attorney-General for India/the Solicitor-General of India/the Additional Solicitor-General of India- in consultation with the Department of Legal Affairs ("DOLA") for file SLP before Hon'ble Supreme Court of India -reg.

Zonal Railways send the proposals to Railway Board mentioning the facts of the any case to get the opinion of Law Officer-Attorney-General for India/the Solicitor-General of India/the Additional Solicitor-General of India- in consultation with the Department of Legal Affairs ("DOLA") for file SLP before Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

Herein in Board's office, the case then examine in consultation with Legal Directorate, Railway Board and forward it to Central Agency Section (CAS), Hon'ble Supreme Court of India for further examination and to get opinion of any Law Officer.

Further, it is noted that the said proposals received from Zonal Railways usually do not found in order with referencing of all RUDs, self-contained note mentioning the facts of case, chronological sequence of events, Rule policy relating to which appeal transferred, legible copies of all relevant documents etc.

It is, therefore, advised to send the proposals for filing SLPs in proper order and on following observations so the appropriate actions may be taken accordingly-

1. Self Contained note mentioning facts of the case.
2. Chronological sequence of events in tabular form duly flagged.
3. Rules/Policy relating to the point on which appeal is being transferred.
4. Certified copies of the various Courts orders/judgments duly flagged.
5. Grounds taken by the petitioner and respondent before various courts.
6. Legible copies of all the relevant documents and correspondences relating to the case duly flagged as A, B, C etc.
7. The details of any pending or decided matter on issue similar to the one which has been referred may also be given.
8. The question of law and the grounds on which appeal is preferred.
