NOTIFICATION

Sub: Formation of panel for the post of Goods Guards in Level-5 of Pay Matrix-2016 (Grade Pay of ₹ 2800) against 60% Departmental quota in Traffic (Running) Department of Secunderabad Division - Reg

It is proposed to hold a selection for 276 (SC-26, ST-24, UR-226) vacancies of Goods Guard in Level-5 of Pay Matrix-2016 (Grade Pay of ₹ 2800) against 60% Dept. quota in Operating (Rg) Department.

1. Eligible Categories of staff as per Para 124[1] of IREM Vol-1.

All Serving regular non-ministerial Group 'C' employees in the Operating and Commercial Departments with a minimum of three years of service as on the date of notification i.e. as on 01-11-2018 and are working **in the following categories** and fulfill the conditions as stipulated hereunder are only eligible to apply:

- TNC in Level-2 (GP ₹ 1900), / Sr. TNC in Level-4 (GP ₹ 2400) with minimum service of three years as on 01-11-2018 in the category.
- Commercial Clerks (Pre-merged) in Level-3 (GP ₹ 2000), TEs in Level-3 (GP ₹ 2000) with minimum service of three years as on 01-11-2018 in the respective post.
- Yard staff: Pointsman/ Switchmen/ Leverman/ Shuntman in Level-2 (GP ₹ 1900) and Cabinman / Sr. Cabinman in Level-2 (GP ₹ 1900)/ Level-4 (GP ₹ 2400) with minimum service of three years as on 01-11-2018 in the respective post.
- Shunting Master-Gr.II / Shunting Jamadar in Level-4 (GP ₹ 2400) with minimum service of three years as on 01-11-2018 in the respective post.

2. The vacancies earmarked for different streams are as under:

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In case of adequate number of candidates from the eligible categories are not forthcoming, the shortfall in the particular category will be made good from the other eligible categories vide CPO/SC letter No.P(T)/529/Tfc.Rg.Staff dated 10-06-1999.

3. Mode of Selection:

In terms of Railway Board's Lr.No.E (NG) I/2000/PM1/41, dated 20-08-2003, S.C.N.144/2003, the positive act of selection to assess the professional ability of the candidate shall consist of only written test. The candidates have to obtain a minimum of 60% marks in professional ability for being considered for further selection process of perusal of service record. The post of Goods Guard being classified as "Safety Category post" there is no relaxation in qualifying marks to Reserved Community employees.

4. Procedure for written examination:

In terms of Railway Board's Lr.No.E(NG)I-2006/PM1/18,dated 30.08.2006, CPO/SC's S.C.No.142/2006, the written examination consists of objective as well as narrative type questions.

In terms of instructions contained in CPO/SC's S.C.No.47/96, questions on official language will form part of the professional ability for 10% of total marks. Inclusion of the questions on official language policy in the Question paper is compulsory but there shall not be any compulsion on the part of the candidates to answer such questions.

5. Pre-Selection Coaching:

In terms of instructions contained in Railway Board's Lr.No88-E(SCT)I/42/2, dated 8/11.01.1991.,CPO/SC's S.C.No73/91, pre-selection coaching to eligible SC/ST employees shall be imparted as per the syllabus for a period of 3 to 4 weeks. After completion of the pre-selection coaching, a certificate has to be issued by the controlling officer to the effect that all the eligible SC/ST employees have been imparted pre-selection coaching for a period of 3 to 4 weeks covering the syllabus prescribed for the examination. In case, any employee expressed his unwillingness for pre-selection, a written declaration to that effect may be forwarded to this office.

6. Question Bank:

In terms of Railway Board's Lr.No.E(NG)I-2006/PM1/34,dated 06.11.2006,CPO/SC's S.C.No.196/2006, updated Question banks covering the complete syllabus will be provided to the staff concerned or the same can be downloaded from the official website of www.scr.inidanrailways.gov.in. It is to advise that the Questions in 'Q' Bank are only indicative in nature but not exhaustive. Candidates are advised to keep update their knowledge/information from the latest rules, circulars and instructions issued by Administration. (It is the duty of the controlling officer to ensure that the question bank is circulated to all the eligible staff and postponement of selection due to non-circulation of question banks will be viewed seriously).
