NOTIFICATION

Sub: Re-engagement of Retired Railway Officers in exigencies of services-reg.

In terms of Railway Board's letters No. 2018/Trans Cell/S&T/Contractual Staff dated 25.10.2018, it is proposed to fill up the following vacancy in the office of Sr.DPO/GTL by re-engagement of retired railway Officer.

Applications in prescribed proforma (Annexure-A) along with required enclosures are invited from the Railway officers who have retired from Personnel Department from the category of APO/SPO/DPO. Applications should be addressed to the Principal Chief Personnel Officer/SCR/SC.

The terms and conditions for the re-engagement of retired officers are as under:


1. The scheme is valid up to 24.10.2020.
2. The re-engagement shall be strictly up to the age of 65 years on or before 24.10.2020 or till the availability of regular candidates/officers from UPSC/Departmental selection whichever is earlier.
3. The maximum upper age limit for Re-engagement of officer is 65 years. No re-engaged officers should continue in service beyond 65 years of age.
4. The administration is at liberty to terminate the services of the re-engaged officers even before 24.10.2020 in case their work/ conduct is found unsatisfactory.
5. The officers removed/dismissed /compulsory retired as a result of disciplinary action or in review, are not eligible for Re-engagement. Further those who retire under SRRS/LARGESS will not be eligible.
6. The re-engaged officers are not entitled for any other benefits or facilities such as HRA,CCA, Transport Allowance, Residential accommodation,etc. However, when required to travel in connection with official work, TA/DA admissible to regular employee working in the same grade will be admissible.
7. The designation shall be consultant followed by (trade name) i.e., officer appointed against the post of APO may be designated as Consultant (Pers).
8. Re-engaged officer shall be given the responsibilities like inspections, supervision, drawings, etc.
9. Re-engaged officer shall not be made in charge of the unit like Branch Officer in the Division.
10. Re-engaged officer shall not be given the financial and D&AR powers and shall not be authorized to issue any safety certificate.

11. The consultant shall not divulge any information gathered by him/her during the period of assignment related to the organization to anyone who is not authorized to know/have the same.
12. The remuneration for re-engaged officer is fixed as monthly remuneration determined by reducing pension from his/her last pay drawn(i.e., Basic +DA).
13. Re-engaged officers shall be on duty on normal duty hours followed in the office in which they are posted. The duty hours can be changed as per the requirement of work by the administration. 12 days leave in a calendar year on pro-rata basis is admissible. For absence if any, appropriate deduction will be made from the monthly remuneration.
14. Re-engagement shall be subject to prescribed medical standards for the category of APO.
15. The retired officers shall execute an agreement to abide by all the terms and conditions of their re-engagement.
16. Suitable/Competency of the applicant shall be adjudged by competent authority before their re-engagement.
17. Re-engaged officer shall be discharged immediately on joining of selected candidate(s) from UPSC or departmental selection or as per the recommendation of PHOD/CHOD concerned.
18. The re-engaged retired officers will have to give minimum 7 days notice for discontinuing the service.
19. Copy of following documents should be attached with the application and it is mandatory.
 - a) Service certificate and Pensioner Identity Card.
 - b) Pension Payment Order
20. The last date for submission of the application is 16.12.2019. Applications received after the due date will not be entertained.
21. The re-engaged officer should be willing to work in Sr.DPO office/GTL on SC Railway.
