

Carriage Repair Shop- Tirupati

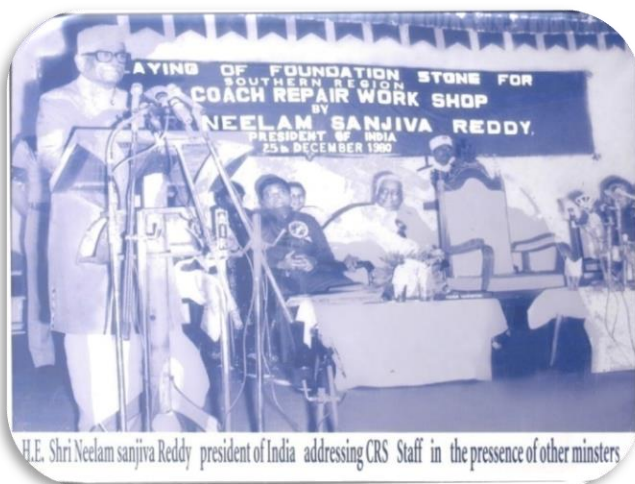


The project for construction of Tirupati Workshop was inaugurated by the then President of India, Dr. N. Sanjeeva Reddy on 25-12-1980. Construction of workshop was completed at a cost of Rs. 53.85 Crores. First coach was turned out in the month of September 1985. Carriage Repair Shop is situated near the divine foot hills of Lord Venkateswara at a distance of 8 KMs from the Temple town Tirupati and 3 KMs from Renigunta.

The workshop had made a beginning with a monthly outturn of 12 coaches in 1986-87, gradually reached the level of 40 coaches per month in the year 2000-01.

With introduction of Group Incentive Scheme in January 2002, the outturn had touched to a level of 60 coaches per month.

This was achieved without induction of additional manpower by duly redeploying the existing man power. Further, on sanction of additional 390 posts @ 135R, the outturn ultimately reached 85 coaches per month since April 2007, and for the current year the revised target is fixed as 98 coaches per month + supply of 170 IOH bogies per month to Divisions
