Sub: Proposal for re-engagement of Retired Railway Junior Scale Officer on monthly remuneration basis in Electrical exigencies of services of Gati Shakti Units(GSUs) in Secunderabad Division.

Ref: Railway Board letter No.2021/W-I/Genl./Gati Shakti dated 27.07.2022& 20.02.2023

In terms of Railway Board's letter cited under reference, it has been decided to fill up under tabulated posts in Gati Shakti Unit on Secunderabad Division by re-engagement of retired staff.

Applications are invited from retired Railway officers who fulfill the following eligibility conditions for the post as indicated above on monthly remuneration basis for the Gati Shakti Unit of Secunderabad Division. The applications should be submitted by **13.09.2024**

The following terms and conditions may kindly be noted:-

The re-engagement will be valid for a period of one year from the date of engagement and will be extended time to time as per administrative requirements.

- 1. Only online applications will be entertained.
- 2. Applications can be submitted through https://cutt.ly/GSUSCSCR
- 3. The last date for submission of the application is **13.09.2024**. Any applications received after the deadline will not be accepted
- 4. Only retired railway employees are eligible to apply.
- 5. Re-engagement is for a period of one year.
- 6. The re-engagement shall not be beyond attaining the age of 65 years. No re-engaged employee should continue in service beyond 65 years of age.
- 7. The Administration is at liberty to terminate the services of the re-engaged employees even before completion of his term in case their work/conduct is found unsatisfactory by giving a notice of 7 days. The re-engaged retired staff should give a notice of 7 days before discontinuing his service.

- 8. The employees Removed/Dismissed/Compulsory retired as a result of DAR action or under review are not eligible for re-engagement. Further employees retired under Safety Related Retirement Scheme (SRRS)/LARSGESS are not eligible.
- 9. The re-engaged employees are entitled only for monthly fixed remuneration i.e. reducing pension from his/her last pay drawn, (i.e. Basic +DA) at the time of retirement. The monthly fixed remuneration plus full pension shall not exceed the last pay drawn at the time of retirement.
- 10. The re-engaged employee will not be eligible for any kind of leave (like CL, LAP, Sick Leave etc). For absence if any, appropriate deduction from salary/wages will be made from the monthly remuneration.
- 11. The re-engaged employees are not entitled for any other benefit or facilities except the monthly fixed remuneration.
- 12. The retired employee shall execute an agreement to abide by all the terms and conditions of the re-engagement.
- 13. Re-engagement shall be subject to prescribed medical fitness for the relevant category.
- 14. Suitability/competency of the applicant shall be adjudged by nominated committee by the way of personal interview before their re-engagement.
- 15. The duty hours of the re-engaged employees would be 8 hours duty or as required. The duty can be changed as per the requirement of works by the administration with weekly off for one day.
- 16. Copy of any of the following documents should be attached with the application & it is Mandatory.
 - (i) Service Certificate (ii) Pensioner Identity Card (iii) Pension Payment Order.
- 17. While assigning the duties the safety and other operational requirements will be adequately considered.
- 18. TA/DA is payable as applicable.
